



### Volunteer Guidelines

1. I will keep the identities of families in the WEC Special Stars Soccer League confidential. This means I will not share their information without their knowledge or consent. This confidentiality extends after my involvement with the program.
2. Corporal punishment is not to be used with any of the children, parents or other volunteers involved with the WEC Special Stars Soccer League. If a child is having a meltdown or needs redirection, I will leave this up to his/her parents. If a child is breaking the rules of WEC Special Stars Soccer League, I will follow the consequence guidelines set out in the document governing their division. If there is a disagreement between myself and anyone else that I cannot feel I can resolve without raising my voice, insulting someone or resulting to violence, I should go to the convenor and ask for conflict resolution from him on the matter.
3. I will not use threatening or abusive language while acting as a volunteer for the WEC Special Stars Soccer League. This includes insults, racist comments or other derogatory or demeaning words about religion, sexual orientation, ability or gender.
4. I realize that I must live up to my promise as a volunteer and therefore will inform the convenor if I will be unable to attend a practice, meeting, registration or other function that I am expected to attend as a representative of WEC Special Stars Soccer League. I will let the convenor know of my absence with as much advance notice as possible and will not call or email any later than 11am on the day I am supposed to volunteer.
5. I will not bring undue liability upon the WEC Special Stars Soccer League as a volunteer. This means I shall not escort children to the washroom, I shall not imply favoritism for certain children by accepting gifts over \$10 in value from a family or child, nor interfere when a child is injured as I am not a medical professional.
